

BSI SPORTS MANAGEMENT BURSARY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DEFINITIONS

- “Applicant” means the person applying for the bursary
- “Station” means the HOT 1027FM (Pty) Limited, the licensed broadcaster of the HOT1027FM radio station
- “Charity” means Hot Cares NPC
- “Bursary Sponsor” means the Balderstone Sports Institute (BSI)
- “Recipient” means the Applicant who has been awarded the bursary
- “Media” means printed media, radio and television and includes social media

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPLYING FOR AND RECEIVING THE BURSARY

1. By applying for the BSI Sports Management Bursary, the Applicant is indicating his/her agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions as well as their eligibility to do so.
2. The Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions; suspend or cancel the bursary programme.
3. Applications for the BSI Sports Management Bursary are open from 12 December 2025 to midnight on 16th January 2026. No late submissions will be considered.
4. The Recipient of the bursary will be notified before 23 January 2026.
5. The Applicant must comply with the below criteria;
 - a. South African citizen or permanent resident
 - b. Reside within Gauteng
 - c. Minimum requirement of a matric certificate
6. The Applicant must submit all of the criteria listed below in order to be considered eligible for bursary consideration:
 - a. Matric results (a matric pass rate is required)
 - b. Copy of South African ID
 - c. A motivation letter or video stating why they deserve the bursary, information on family background and situation, passion for sport and sporting background, why they want to pursue a career in sport, how they would make a difference with the qualification.
7. The selection process is subject to the decision of the Bursary Sponsor, whose decision is final. No negotiations and/or correspondence whatsoever will be entered into, whether before or after a decision has been made in respect of the bursary.
8. The bursary is for a 1-year BSI Sports Management Higher Certificate (NQF5), at Balderstone Sports Institute in Bedfordview Johannesburg:
 - a. Value: R27 750
 - b. Start date: 9th February 2026
 - c. Duration: 1 year
 - d. Includes: Student pack (2 x t-shirts, 1 x top, 1 x cap), All course material (electronic), Attendance at BSI graduation dinner for each student (guests can attend at a cost), access to BSI Fitness Centre
9. The bursary excludes:
 - a. accommodation, meals, transport, sports training

10. The Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor reserves the right to refuse participation for any reason whatsoever, provided that such right is not exercised so as to discriminate on the basis of the Applicant's race, sex, gender, sexual orientation, religious orientation or political persuasion.
11. No employee, independent contractor (including any presenter) nor any immediate family member of anyone employed by the Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor may apply.
12. If the selected Recipient cannot be contacted successfully within a period of **48 Hours**, and/or is ineligible to accept the bursary or contravenes the terms and conditions of the bursary, the bursary will be forfeited, and a new Recipient will be selected from the applications received.
13. The Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor will not be held liable or responsible for any late or incorrect applications as a result of any technical faults beyond the reasonable control of the Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor.
14. The Applicant acknowledges and agrees that, in the event of receiving the bursary which involves any travel, there are inherent risks associated with such travel and/or the relevant destination and the Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor will not be held liable for any loss, damage or harm suffered as a result thereof.
15. The bursary is not transferrable and may not be exchanged for cash or an alternative.
16. The Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor reserves the right to request verification of your application to ensure that the correct Applicant is taking up the bursary. Such verification may require the Recipient to, without limitation, provide proof of their address and contact details and confirmation of their identity number. The Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor will only accept the Recipient if it is satisfied that the information furnished by the Recipient is true.
17. By agreeing to these terms and conditions, the Applicant consents to the Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor processing personal information in respect of the Applicant, for the purposes of determining the Applicant's eligibility for the bursary.
18. The Applicant indemnifies the Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor and holds it harmless against any claims of any nature arising from, in connection with or as a result of the application's participation in the bursary for any reason whatsoever, and whether or not such loss, damage or harm is attributable to any action or omission (including involving gross negligence) on the part of the Station, Charity and Bursary Sponsor, its employees and/or its independent contractors.
19. By accepting the bursary, the Recipient consents to interviews and the publication of their photograph in the Media with no remuneration due to the Recipient.
